I. What is Vox 2.0?

- A fully revamped and upgraded version of Vox 1
- A groundbreaking learning management system (LMS)
- Developed at the University of Hong Kong by Faculty of Dentistry and TALIC

Al Enhanced Learning (In Development)

- O Key Feature 4: Al-Generated Transcription & Summaries
 - Automatic transcription of video content for easy reference
 - Al-generated summary notes to support personalized learning
- Key Feature 5: Seamless Integration with Existing LMS i.e. Moodle
 - Compatible with flipped classrooms, pre-class learning, and hybrid teaching
 - Supports students' preference for video content and re-watching capabilities
- O Key Feature 6: 3D Image Viewer
 - Enhances visual learning and immersive educational experience
 - Facilitates understanding of complex structures and concepts

II. Key Features of Video Vox 2.0

Enchanced Interactive Video Experience

- Key Feature 1: Interactive Video LMS
 - Contemporaneous discussion boards for dynamic student engagement
 - Customizable tagging buttons to guide students' comments on video content
 - Time-tagged teacher feedback & student questions for precise learning support
- Key Feature 2: Comprehensive Learning Analytics
 - Monitor student progress with analytics on video completion and engagement
 - Send email reminders to students for missed content and upcoming tasks
- Key Feature 3: Integrated Quizzes
 - Create customizable questions from uploaded video, audio, and text content
 - Automatic grading for multiple choice questions in quizzes

III. Video Vox 2.0 in Action

- Used across the university in 200+ courses
- Supports flipped classroom, pre-class learning, and hybrid teaching
- Allows insights into student engagement in course content and overall learning
